ABOUT THE ITALIAN AMERICAN MUSEUM OF LOS ANGELES (IAMLA)

The Italian American Museum of Los Angeles is a 21st century interactive museum that documents the history and contributions of Italian Americans in multiethnic Southern California and the nation. Located in one of the oldest remaining buildings from Los Angeles' historic Little Italy, the IAMLA features exhibitions and a variety of cultural-educational programming.

ABOUT THE INTERNSHIP

The internship will consist of working with the museum's director to create educational activities, programs, and curricula for K-12 students. A modest amount of guided research on topics pertaining to local and United States history will be required. The internship will take place at the museum's downtown Los Angeles offices. The work will be partially independent; weekly meetings with the museum's director will provide constructive guidance and feedback. This internship is part-time and unpaid. Volunteer or course credit can be arranged. At least five hours a week are required.

QUALIFICATIONS OF APPLICANT:

The project requires well-organized, highly reliable, motivated candidates who demonstrates a desire to work in the field of education and/or museum education. While this position is non-paid, the intern/research assistant will gain valuable skills, experience, and knowledge of Los Angeles' diverse historical landscape and work experience in a museum environment. Applicants must be reliable and hard-working, have some background in education and research experience, and ideally, possess a 3.4 or better GPA. Education, social science, history, art history, and museum studies majors are preferred.
